Sermon: The Long Way To Certain Deliverance

Passage: Daniel 11:2 - 12:13 (ESV)

Illustration:

Need: The plans and purposes of God may be long but they are certain, determined and will conclude in ultimate victory!

I. Times of Trouble Precede the Time of Israel's Deliverance (11:36-12:1)

- We must remember that the book of Daniel deals with national Israel & the gentile world kingdoms.
- 11:2-12:4 give incredible detail of the 70 weeks of years revealed in 9:24-27.
- 11:2-35 = 370+ years of past history (536-163 BC). 135 statements of prophecy already fulfilled.
- 11:21-35 = Antiochus IV Epiphanes from 8:9-22 (the little horn, after the four horns, after the great horn on the Goat that defeated the Ram of Daniel's second vision in chapter 8) the archetype of Anti-christ.
- 11:36-45 = a still future world leader, Anti-christ, like Antiochus IV but far greater in power and ability (the little horn, after the 10 horns on the fourth beast of Daniel's first vision in chapter 7).
- Anti-christ will bring great tribulation, "a time of trouble, such as never has been since there was a nation till that time" (12:1; Jer. 30:7; Matt. 24:21-22; Matt 25; Rev. 13-18)
- As powerful as Anti-christ will be, his end will be sudden and definitive (11:45; 9:27; 8:25; 7:11, 26; 2:44-45) as God has decreed at the return of the Lord Jesus Christ (Rev. 19:19-20; Zech. 14:1-4).

II. Israel's Deliverance is Certain and Secure (12:1-13)

- At the end of this time, national Israel will ultimately be delivered by God as He promised (12:1).
- Bodily resurrection will occur for those of God's chosen earthly people who by faith trusted His promises (12:2; Get. 22:5; Heb. 11:19; Job 19:25-26; Isa. 25:8; 26:19; Hos. 13:14; Ps. 16:9-10).
- The delivered children of Israel will be rewarded for their faithfulness (12:3).
- The time of tribulation under Anti-christ will be "for a time, times and half a time" (12:7; 7:25; Rev. 12:14) or 3 1/2 years.
- Those who respond to God will understand and remain faithful; the wicked will not understand and remain in their wickedness (12:10)
- Until then, Daniel was to continue on faithfully until his death. Then in the future he too would be numbered among the faithful delivered (12:13).

III. Concluding Principles from Daniel for Believers:

- God is absolutely sovereign over all creation, human authority and history.
- God is faithful and active in the lives of His faithful people at all times.
- People of God must expect to experience times of suffering.
- God's will, plans and purpose will be completed exactly as the scripture reveals.
- The Son of Man has come to provide salvation and will return to establish His Kingdom.
- We too have "a way" to go till the end actively making disciples.
- We too have an "allowed place at the end of days" with Christ at His return.
