Sermon: CONNECT

Passage: Various

Illustration:

Need: God has designed Christians to live their life in the context of interconnected, intentional community.

I. God designed humans for community.

- Gen. 1:27 = created in God's image and God is in community Father, Son & HS.
- Gen. 2:18 = marriage "not good that the man should be alone."
- Gen. 1:28 = family/procreation "be fruitful and multiply."

II. God designed His people to function as community.

- Gen. 12:2 = Israel was a covenant people of God's creation "I will make you a great nation."
- 1 Cor. 12:12-13: 26-27 = God's church is one body with many interdependent interconnected members.
- **Eph. 4:4-6** = our common denominators are the indwelling Holy Spirit, faith in Jesus confessed in public baptism, and our Heavenly Father.
- Heb. 10:24-25 = believers are called to actively wade into the community not isolate from it.
- The NT contains close to 50 "one another" instructions for how believers are to engage with others for their benefit love, encourage, bear burdens, bear with, comfort, welcome, care for, submit to, etc...
- Disciples of Jesus Christ obey Him by embracing the community that He has designed us for.

III. CONNECTing at Oasis Church

- Corporate worship is vitally important to spiritual health of every believer but it's not CONNECTing.
- CONNECTing is the intentional, vulnerable and regular engagement with other believers.
- LifeGroups, LifeGroups! Our #1 connection tool at OC is the adult LifeGroup.
- In a LifeGroup is where you practice the "one anothers" of a disciple.
- CONNECTion is messy and it's natural to want to withdraw and isolate, but that is withdrawing from what God has called us to embrace "one another."
- Men's and Women's groups, young adult groups, students & Kidz ministry also provide CONNECTion.
- Our #2 connection tool at OC is Covenant Partnership (church membership).
- Covenant Partnership is the vehicle for intentional commitment to the philosophy, ministry strategy, and accountability to Oasis Church.

IV. Take it personally.

- CONNECTing in the body as a disciple of Jesus begins with saving faith in Jesus. Trust Him today.
- Commit to weekly worship attendance for your own spiritual health and that of your family.
- If Oasis is your church, decide to get CONNECTed this year.
 - Adults & young adults, join a LifeGroup this fall.
 - Become an OC Covenant Partner or answer the question "Why would I not?"
 - Parents, get your children here on Wednesday nights for BT & Kidz TOAST.
