Illustration:

Need: When God opens the door for us to share the gospel with our one, we must share it with care, completeness and accuracy.

I. The Gospel IS NOT...

- Believing in God. (James 2:19) Moralistic Therapeutic Deism
- Being a "person of faith," a "religious person," going to church, trying to be a good person.
- Baptism or a story of how God has worked things out in your life. Reading the Bible and praying more.
- An experience or warm feeling that God was with me and everything is now okay.
- Telling someone that God loves them and they just need to let Him guide their life. (both are true but they are NOT the gospel)

II. The Gospel IS...

- Romans 1:16; 1 Cor. 15:1-8 The word gospel means "Good News." It is the divine truth about the love of God and work of Jesus that, when received, brings sinners into right relationship with God!
- The gospel must be presented with care, completeness, and accuracy.
 - Sin & its consequences (present & eternal).
 - God's love, mercy, & grace revealed in Jesus, God the Son, in His becoming human.
 - Jesus' sinless life, death, and resurrection to pay for our sin and secure our justification.
 - Individual responsibility to respond by faith alone in the person and work of Jesus.
 - Understanding that responding to the gospel is the decision to be a follower of Jesus.
 - An invitation to trust Jesus
- The "way" we share must consider and adjust to the amount of Biblical understanding the hearer has.

III. The Gospel DOES... (when it is embraced)

- Makes us alive (Eph. 2:4-5)
- Sets us free (Gal. 5:1)
- Makes us new (2 Cor. 5:17)
- Brings forgiveness & cleansing (1 John 1:9)
- Establishes our Redemption (Gal. 3:13) & Justification (Gal. 2:16).
- Seals & secures us through the Holy Spirit. (John 10:27-30; Rom. 8:38-39; 1 Pet. 1:3-5; Eph. 1:13-14)
- Initiates, Equips, Empowers, Entrusts, & Activates us as representatives of Jesus. (Matt. 28:19-20; Acts 1:8)

IV. The Gospel DOES NOT...

- Give believers a license to live as they choose.
- Fix all our problems and circumstances.
- Guarantee that all our goals and dreams will be fulfilled.
- Guarantee that we will experience physical health, monetary wealth, or earthly happiness.

The Romans Road

- Everyone is a sinner Rom. 3:10, 23; 5:12
- Sinners deserve death and condemnation Rom. 5:18a; 6:23a
- God loves sinners Rom. 5:8, 18b, 19b; 6:23b
- Sinners receive God's free gift only by faith Rom. 10:9-13; (Eph. 2:8-9)
- Do you believe in your heart? Will you confess with your mouth?

Project 3:16 (John 3:16)

- God Loved
- God Gave
- We Believe
- We Live

- Black page represents the darkness and death that we are in because of sin.
